



FreightScan Appoints Larry Fullerton Chief Scientist

- Internationally Renowned Data Communications Expert Heads Engineering Developments -

Solana Beach, California, October 23, 2008 – FreightScan, LLC, a leader in the development and deployment of innovative technology solutions for the freight and logistics industry, announced it has appointed Larry Fullerton, an internationally recognized expert in the fields of ultra wideband impulse radio and radar technologies, to the position of Chief Scientist for the Company.

Mr. Fullerton is recognized as a co-inventor on more than 150 patents and pending patent applications in the fields of time-domain electromagnetism, ultrasound velocimetry (the measurement of the velocity of fluids), data communications and seismic exploratory instrumentation (both U.S. and foreign). In 1987, he founded Time Domain Corporation, a world leader in ultra wideband (UWB) product development, whose applications include foliage penetrating radar, into-the-ground radar for both military and civil uses, intrusion detection systems, through-wall radar, location and tracking systems and wireless ultra wideband communications of both voice and digital information.

His technological development work at Time Domain led to contracts with the Army Missile Command, the Army Strategic Defense Command and the Marine Corps., the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA), an agency of the United States Department of Defense responsible for the development of new technology for use by the military, as well as the Immigration and Naturalization Service Agency and other organizations. Time Domain's technology is now a contender for the new IEEE 802.11 UWB wireless standard.

Previously, Mr. Fullerton was the Chief Scientist of Midsouth Technology, Inc. and held engineering positions at Texas Instruments, Computer Sciences Corporation, and ITT Telecommunications. Mr. Fullerton earned a BS in Electrical Engineering from the University of Arkansas, and his work has been featured in national media including the *New York Times*, *USA Today*, *Discover*, *U.S. News and World Report*, and other publications.
