

**ITI BOARD OF DIRECTORS SPRING MEETING AND TRANSPORTATION POLICY FORUM
HELD IN WASHINGTON, D.C.**

Elects Two New Board Members - Discusses National Transportation Infrastructure Policy

DENVER, CO, May 11, 2009 – The Board of Directors of the Intermodal Transportation Institute (ITI) at the University of Denver held its spring meeting recently at the Georgetown Inn in Washington, D.C. Guest speakers at the Board meeting included Charles W. Moorman, Chairman, President, and Chief Executive Officer of Norfolk Southern Corporation, and Joseph Boardman, President and Chief Executive Officer of Amtrak.

The ITI Board also elected two new Board members. William L. Bourque, Vice President of Marketing for The Greenbrier Companies, and Mark L. Joseph, Chief Executive Officer and Vice Chairman of Veolia Transportation North America and Chairman of Veolia Transportation on Demand. They were elected to a three-year term on the more than 50-member ITI Board of Directors, which is made up of a broad spectrum of industry leaders from all transportation modes.

In association with the Eno Transportation Foundation, the ITI Board also hosted a forum on transportation policy in 2009.
