- Establishes Strategic Partnership with Air Cargo Veteran Luis F. Paredes to Oversee Latin America Operations -

“FreightScan’s suite of dimensioning products creates significant value for cargo companies around the world, and we have developed an application specifically for the agricultural trade in Latin America to improve accuracy and efficiency,” said Richards.

FreightScan has several installations and evaluations taking place throughout North America and is continuing to develop strategic partnerships to handle its pioneering scanning systems for the automated dimensioning of cargo in Europe and the Asian Pacific region, as well as Latin America.
